

Covid-19 Protection Framework – January 2022 V1

	In Person Workshops	Meetings On-site
RED	 In person workshops will go ahead based on 1m spacing. Vaccine pass will be required from all participants and presenters/facilitators. Face coverings will need to worn at all times All surfaces will be sanitised before workshop commences. We will ensure there is good ventilation in the space. You will be required to scan in/record your attendance for contact tracing. Maximum participants number will be 15-20depending on venue size. No refreshments will be provided. On full day workshops participants will be asked to bring their own refreshments – break times and space will be made available. Hand sanitiser and face masks will be made available. 	No in person meetings will be held on-site. These will instead take place via video conference (i.e ZOOM) or by telephone.
ORANGE	 In person workshops will go ahead. Vaccine pass will not be required unless required by the venue in use. Face coverings are encouraged and if distancing is not possible they will be required. All surfaces will be sanitised before workshop commences. We will ensure there is good ventilation in the space. You will be required to scan in/record your attendance for contact tracing. Maximum participants up to 50 depending on venue size and government guidelines at the time. Refreshments will be provided, participants will be required to self-serve. Hand sanitiser and face masks will be made available. 	Without Vaccine Pass: Meetings can be held in our meeting room with adequate spacing, ventilation, record keeping/scanning for contact tracing. In line with 1m spacing this will be a maximum of 6 people or within the latest government guidelines. With Vaccine Pass: Meetings can be held in our meeting room with adequate spacing, ventilation, record keeping/scanning for contact tracing. A maximum of 11 people or within the latest government guidelines.
